DONATION PROCESS

- Donations will be sorted by program guests, volunteers, and staff before being accepted.
- 2 Items able to be sold are kept and stored in inventory for Blessings & More.
- 3 Items that are unable to be sold, we recycle, or repurpose through our partnerships with other organizations!

With the capacity to bale and recycle the excess clothing donated for Blessings & More, we can steward our resources more effectively, create employment opportunities for our program participants, and produce additional revenue to invest in the ministries of Neighbors of Hope.
